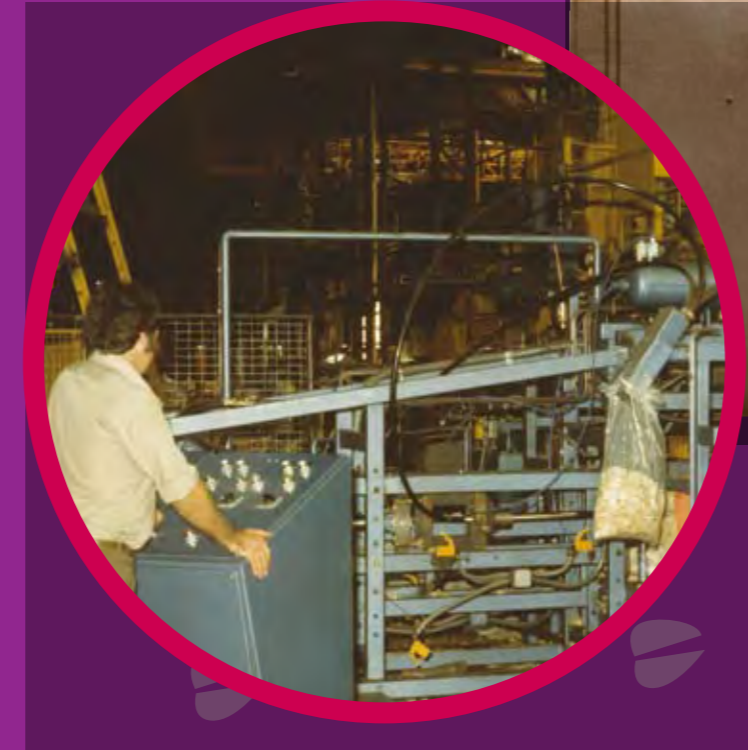


MAKING CLOTHING FROM WOOL



1 The sheep are mustered into yards.

2 The sheep are shorn by shearers.

3 The wool is classed by a wool classer.

4 The wool is baled.

5 The wool is sold to a factory.

6 The wool is washed and dried to remove dust, sheep sweat and wool wax.

7 Rollers covered with teeth tease apart the wool fibres and it is twisted to form a soft rope.

8 Short wool fibres are dyed and spun to make fluffy yarn. Fluffy yarn is knitted to make jumpers, and woven to make jackets, coats, skirts, rugs and blankets.

9 Long wool fibres are combed then dyed and tightly spun to make smooth yarn. Smooth yarn is woven to make fabric. The fabric is cut and sewn to make suits and trousers.

10 The clothes are sold in a shop.
