

Make a sheep sock puppet

Materials

Cream wool sock, plastic lid from the top of a margarine container, pink, black and cream felt, stick-on eyes, cream wool for hair, glue gun, shoulder pads or foam. *Additional: finishing details such as glasses, hats, flowers, brown felt for horns etc.*

What to do

1. Cut a circular piece out of the margarine lid and bend in half. Push it into the sock all the way to the toes to see that it will fit. Remove.
2. Put some low-temp glue on the inside fold of the plastic lid and carefully inset it again. Carefully press in the toe of the sock to meet the inside fold of the lid where the glue is. Hold in position until the glue dries.
3. Insert a shoulder pad into the face area of the puppet to give it a more rounded look.
4. Cut a nose from a piece of black felt. Cut a tongue from a piece of pink felt and two ears from cream felt. Glue them into place.
5. Glue the eyes in place.
6. Glue on some wool hair.
7. *Additional - add finishing touches to create each character.*
